APPLICANTS MUST:

- Hold a valid Florida teaching certificate (or appointment)
- ❖ Enroll in (or be accepted to) a post-baccalaureate degree seeking program related to computer science or instructional computing **OR** be in attainment of a Florida Certification in computer instruction
- ❖ Have at least half of their course of study remaining to be completed
- ❖ Commit to teaching one full year in Florida schools upon program completion

 - ✓ Briefly describe your teaching philosophy and views on educational technology
- ❖ Three letters of recommendation from school administrators, fellow teachers, or FAEDS members
